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## **Toothpick Tower Challenge**

#### Materials List:

- toothpicks
- small marshmallows Note: If you don't have marshmallows, you can use modeling clay to create small balls that are the size of small marshmallows.
- paper
- pencil or pen

### Instructions:

1. On a piece of paper, draw a design for a tower you would like to make.




2. Build your tower using toothpicks and marshmallows. Try to build a big tower!



3. If the tower starts to fall or lean, think of how you can help it to stand up straight.



4. Change your design, as needed, to make the tower look the way you want. Try experimenting with other designs and see how tall a tower you can make.

# **Heart-Shaped Compliment Cards**

#### Materials List:

- 2 different colors of paper or card stock
- glue
- safety scissors
- non-toxic, washable markers or crayons

### Instructions:

1. Take a piece of paper that you want to use to create a heart and fold it in half.



2. Draw a half a heart, starting at the folded edge.



3. Cut along your outline to cut out the heart.



4. Open it up to reveal the heart!



5. Cut the heart in half, lengthwise-from the bottom to the top.



6. Take a piece of paper that is a different color and cut out a strip that is about one inch thick (about the length from the first joint of your index finger to the tip). The strip should be long enough to write a message to someone special.



7. Fold in the sides of the strip of paper so that the ends are touching. Hold the ends at the top and press down on the sides to flatten them.



8. Fold the right end of the strip back over the right side, and the left end back over the left side.



9. Open up the strip of paper and add glue to each end.



10. Attach one half of the heart on one dot of glue and attach the other half of the heart on the other dot of glue.



11. Let it dry. Open it up to reveal the thin strip of paper.



12. On the thin strip of paper, write something nice to someone you care about. Fold it up so the writing is hidden behind the heart. Then, give the compliment card to your person.
