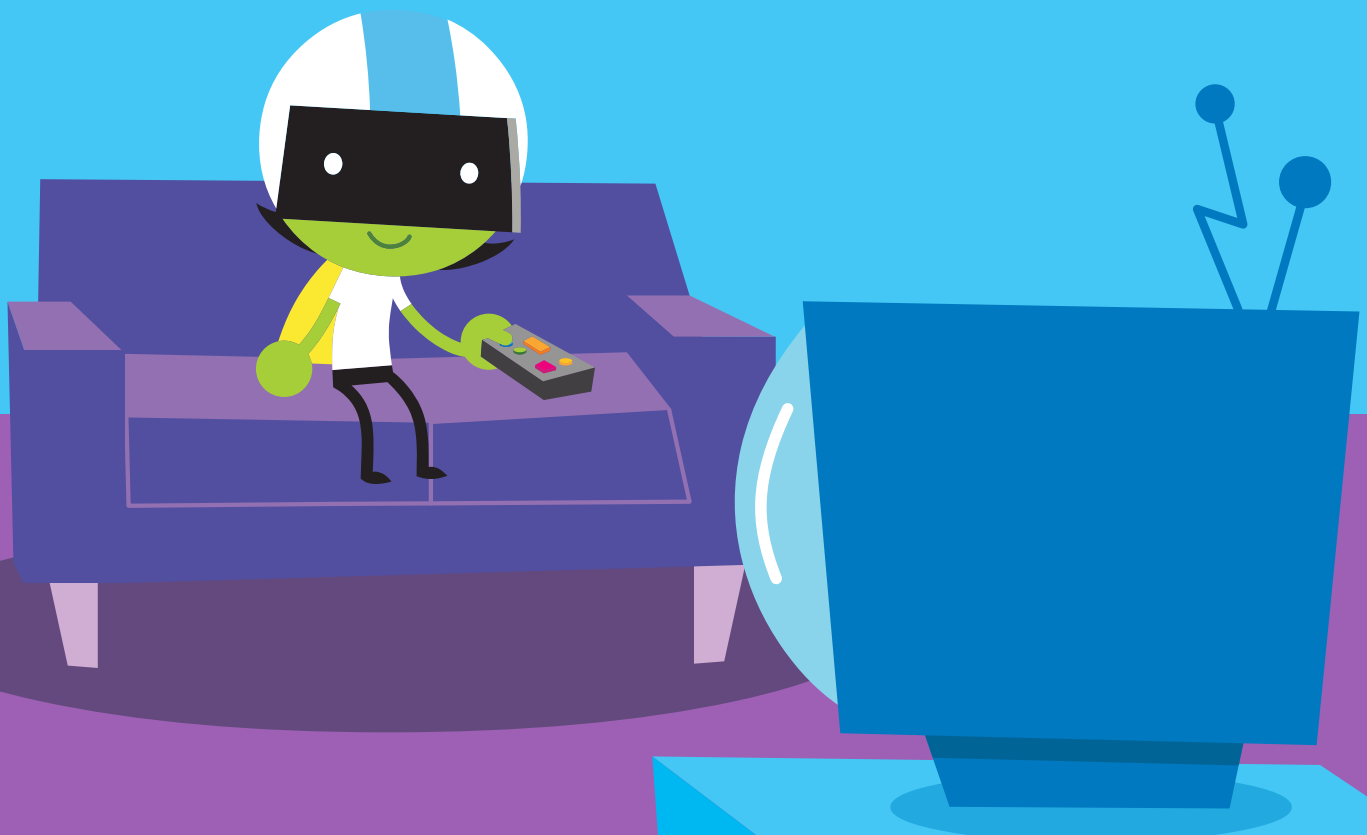

This collection includes 15 videos and activities for grades K – 5.

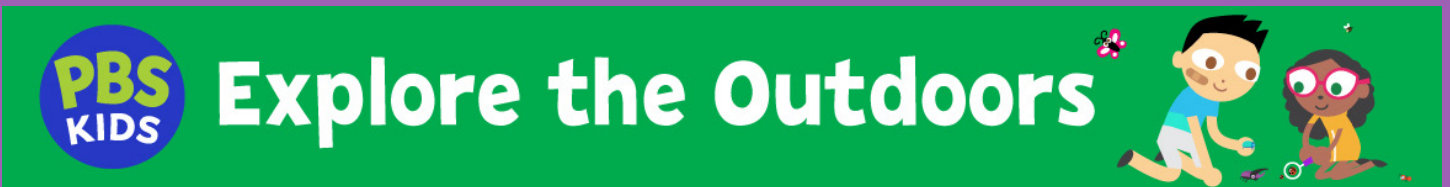

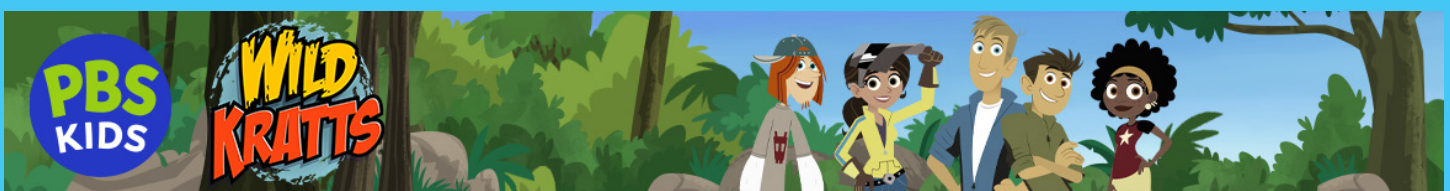
